Academy High Receives \$50,000 Through Invest in Kids Program



Since 2017, the <u>Invest In Kids Scholarship Tax Credit Program</u> has provided funding for students whose families meet income requirements and attend qualified, non-public schools in Illinois.

In September, Academy High received \$50,000 through the Invest in Kids Act to support our Indexed Tuition program. These funds will be used to make Academy High more accessible to more families this school year and beyond!

We are so thankful and proud that each dollar came from donors within our school community whose donation was multiplied by four as part of the program's 75% tax credit incentive (on their state income taxes donors are returned \$3 for every \$4 donated).

Donate Items and Services to the Silent Auction


You can donate items or services to the Silent Auction. From gift baskets to gift cards, leaf raking to snow removal services, your help is appreciated!
