To make this event a success, we need parents and guardians to help with setting up, chaperoning, and tearing down. You can sign up to help here!



3D Printing Field Trip to Illinois MakerLab at UIUC






Cross Country: Strong Start to the Season

Help Academy High Access \$50,000 in Matching Funds to Support Scholarships



Since 2017, Empower Illinois, through the Invest In Kids Scholarship Tax Credit Program, has connected donors with schools to provide funding for students whose families meet income requirements and attend qualified, non-public schools in Illinois - schools like Academy High!

Donors through this program are able to multiply their donations by four due to the program's 75% tax credit incentive. Meaning that on their state income taxes, donors are returned \$3 for every \$4 donated to the school. Check out the table below to see what that means for donors and for Academy High:

*Empower Illinois retains 5% of donations to cover operational costs of the program

Last school year, Academy High received \$94,000 from donors within our school community to support scholarships for Academy High students. Their generous efforts make Academy High accessible to all families, which strengthens all aspects of our community!

This year, previous donors to Academy High have offered to match gifts up to a total of **\$50,000** to help grow participation in this program. Gifts to this program need to be made before December 31, 2023.
